Local Bicton primary school puts Hawaiian grants towards much needed supplies

Bicton Primary School students will benefit from a total of \$1,500 in funding thanks to two grants from Hawaiian's Melville.

Bicton Primary School has received \$1,000 as part of Hawaiian's Schools Program, which supports local schools to provide enhanced educational experiences.
